PENTECOST SUNDAY SUNDAY 19TH MAY 2024

In these days since Easter we have read in the Gospels how the disciples misunderstood what had taken place. They mistook the risen Lord for a gardener, an imagined ghost or a traveller on the road. Perhaps we can sense our own restlessness or anxieties in the disciples who didn't want things to change, who wanted their old earthly Jesus back and looked for distractions or huddled together behind locked doors. After the Ascension and at Pentecost they find new life and new heart as they received the gift of the Spirit that Jesus had promised.



These first Christians go forth, alive with the Spirit, enabling them to witness to the Lord and live the life of faith that they were called to live in the circumstances they found themselves in. So it is with us. Pentecost opens us up to the truth that God never abandons us. This is not an abstract mystery, nor even simply a historical event. It is an invitation to renew our trust in God who sends the Spirit to enable us to share the gifts given to us and to live our faith in the ups and downs of life. Happy Feast Day!
