

SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER (YEAR B) SUNDAY 5TH MAY 2024

Today's reading from St John's Gospel has Jesus teaching about the kind of service that Christians are called upon to offer to others. Jesus reminds his disciples that their knowledge of God is to be expressed in love. Those who know Jesus well and Jesus says that his disciples do know him, will love one another. Knowledge leads to love, which leads to action. Here Jesus teaches that his relationship to his disciples is based on friendship, not servitude. St John reminds his community that Jesus also taught that a disciple is one who had been chosen by Jesus. To be chosen by Jesus, however, is not to be set apart from the world.



To be chosen by Jesus is to be sent to serve; the disciples of Jesus were chosen and were sent into the world to bear fruit by serving others. In the context of John's Gospel, these words are spoken before Jesus' Crucifixion. We read his instruction to the disciples in light of his death and Resurrection. We know that Jesus himself gives us the greatest example of the kind of love and service that he teaches to his disciples. He has, in fact, laid down his life for his friends, for his disciples and for us. Through his death and Resurrection, we have received the grace to love others as Jesus does.
