THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD (YEAR A) 11TH JANUARY 2026

This Sunday and the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, marks a transition from the Christmas season to Ordinary Time. In a way, today's feast is the high point of the Christmas season. Before Jesus' birth, angels announced to Mary and to Joseph who Jesus would be. At his birth, the shepherds and the Magi recognize Jesus as the Messiah.

At his baptism, Jesus accepts that he is God's son and inaugurates that mission. The baptism of Jesus is another manifestation of Christ, another epiphany. Christ's baptism marks the beginning of his ministry and his mission. In a similar way, our Baptism inaugurates our mission as Christians. The baptism of a ritual washing for repentance that John performs, prefigures Christian Baptism in accepting this baptism, Jesus unites himself with all sinners even though he is sinless; the Word made flesh and dwelling among us.
